




- Rapid economic growth and urbanization has
- Increased beef consumption
- And prices notionally increases producer incentives
- But overwhelmed by other factors
  - Farm mechanisation / draught
  - Biological
  - Esp opportunity costs of labour
- = low supply elasticity / response



- Other (incomes) 42%


Bai et al. (2012) Per capita beef consumption 4.5-7.7kg, 30% out-of-home

Taiwan beef consumption (2012) 4.4kg







Nominal monthly meat and corn prices in Beijing 1995-2015 *China Livestock Yearbook (various years)* 




Domestic (blue) and Australian import (red) prices 2011-17 (nominal, Rmb)






Officially reported beef imports and exports through key routes 1992-2016.




